- Develop a prayer focused life

“Phil’s Family of Friends” Midweek Program:

- Faith is expanded by learning, exploring, applying and carrying home a new Bible point each week
- Explore multiple Discovery Centers
- Expand on friendships made on Sunday as well as meet new kids of different ages
- Activities that challenge & help one’s motivational level, social skills & self-esteem
- Meet new and exciting “Special Guests”
- Play games that we just can’t play on Sunday
